



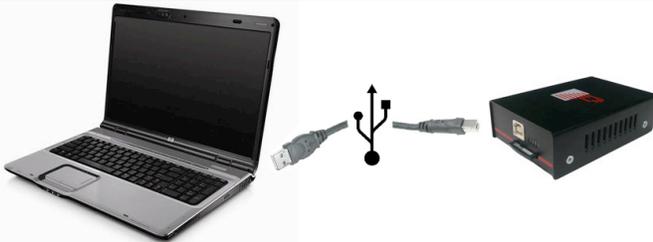
# START HERE

## 1. Install the QuickShow software



Before connecting any cable, install the software included on the CD.  
Follow the on screen instructions.  
After installing the software, return to this guide.

## 2. Plug in the USB cable



Do not plug in the laser projector yet.

The green light next to the USB connector on the Flashback 3 box will come on.

## 3. Install the Flashback 3 drivers

What do you want the wizard to do?

- Install the software automatically (Recommended)
- Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)

Search for the best driver in these locations.

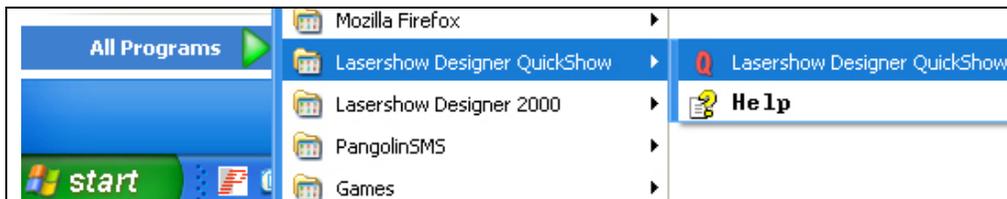
Use the check boxes below to limit or expand the default search, which includes local paths and removable media. The best driver found will be installed.

When you connect the Flashback 3 to USB port of your computer, the 'New Hardware' wizard will appear. You should not use the automatic install procedure. Instead, you should point the wizard to the Drivers directory on the installation CD-ROM.

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## 6. Initial setup

	<p><b>This initial setup will setup your user experience, set your projector’s scanner speed and the number of colors in your projector. Follow the instructions on screen.</b></p>
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## 7. Plug in your projector

	<p><b>A standard DB-25 computer cable can be used to connect the Flashback 3 to the ILDA connector on the projector. Turn on your projector. Some projectors may require to be set to ILDA input.</b></p>
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## 8. Play

	<p><b>Select any cue and click the “Enable Laser Output” button to have it displayed on your projector.</b></p>
